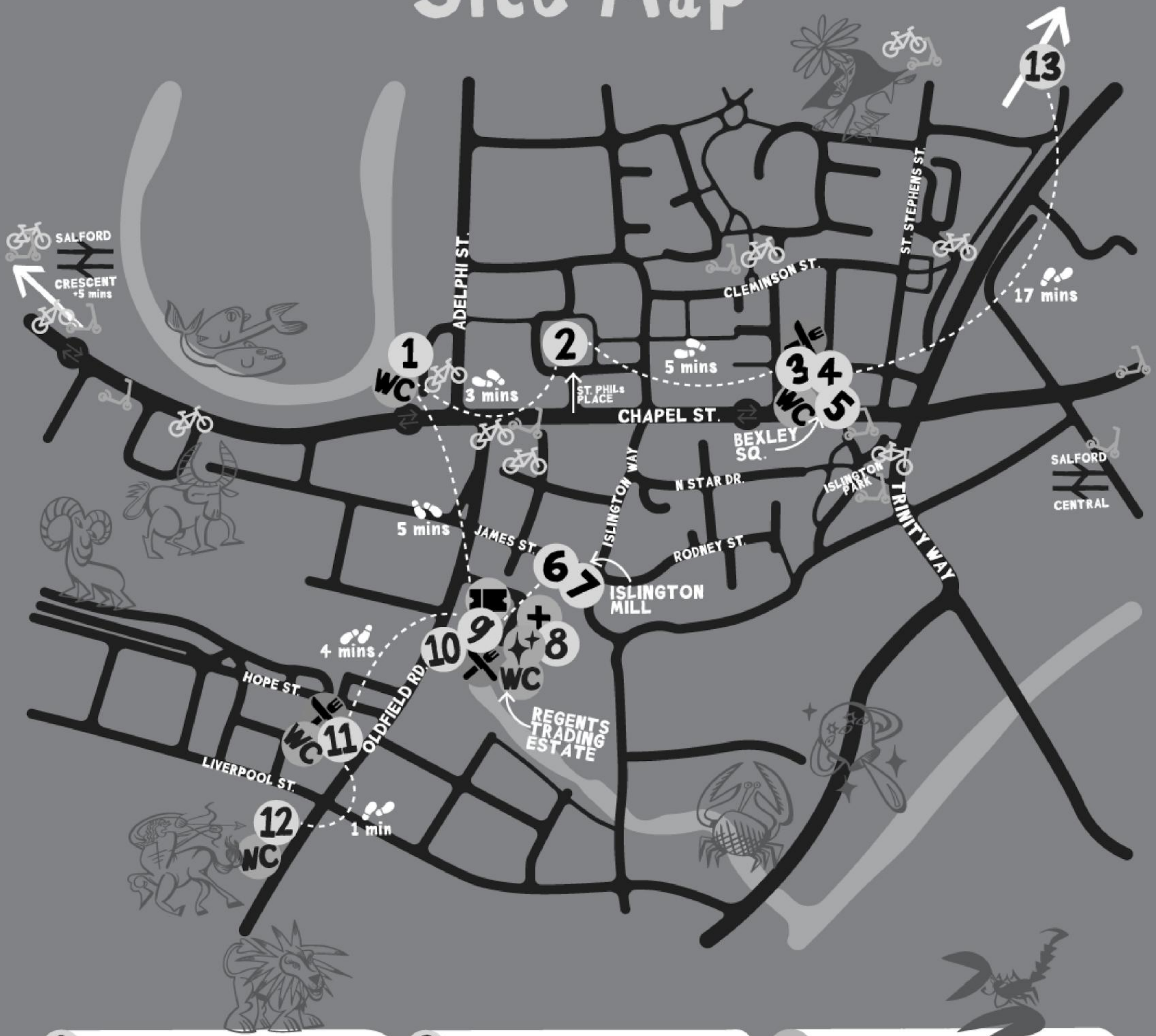

## On Foot

Wristband exchange is a 15-25 min walk from Central Manchester via Bridge Street, Quay Street or Chapel Street.

## By Train

The nearest station is Salford Crescent. Wristband exchange is a 14 min walk from Salford Crescent. \*\*Please note that Salford Central station is temporarily closed for renovation work.

## By Tram

Deansgate, St Peter's Square and Exchange Square tram stops are all a 20 min walk to wristband exchange, and Cornbrook is 25 mins.

## By Bike

TFGM has launched Greater Manchester's first publicly operated, self-service, 24/7 cycle hire scheme. There are bike hubs located right in the heart of the festival: at the Ainscow Hotel, Islington Way, Oldfield Road/Barrow St, and The Old Pint Pot (see the map for all nearby hubs). All hires can be managed via the free Beryl app.

## By Scooter

Scooters can be used for travel around the city up to the boundary with Manchester council. The closest hub is on the corner of Oldfield Road and Chapel Street, only a 2 min walk to wristband exchange (see the map for all nearby hubs). A full map of scooter locations as well as all hires can be managed via the free Lime app.

## By Bus

From Manchester City Centre: You can get a number of buses from Piccadilly Gardens and Shudehill interchange. These buses run frequently even on Bank Holiday Sundays. Ask for a ticket for Chapel St, near Salford Cathedral. The journey should take around 10 mins.

## By car, if you have no other option:

Oldfield Road is just off the A6 Chapel Street and is accessible via the A56 and A57 and the Mancunian Way. Parking is extremely limited around the area. The nearest car park to Chapel Street is Farmer Norton (Peru St, M3 6FS) which is an uncovered pay & display car park.

## **Plug One FM**

Broadcasting live from the festival on our favourite radio station Reform Radio, make sure you swing by and give Baz a wave!

Look for 'Plug One FM' on the map – AKA the back of Unit 2 Regents Trading estate, AKA where Partisan used to be – and we'll have a stream on our homepage on the day too.

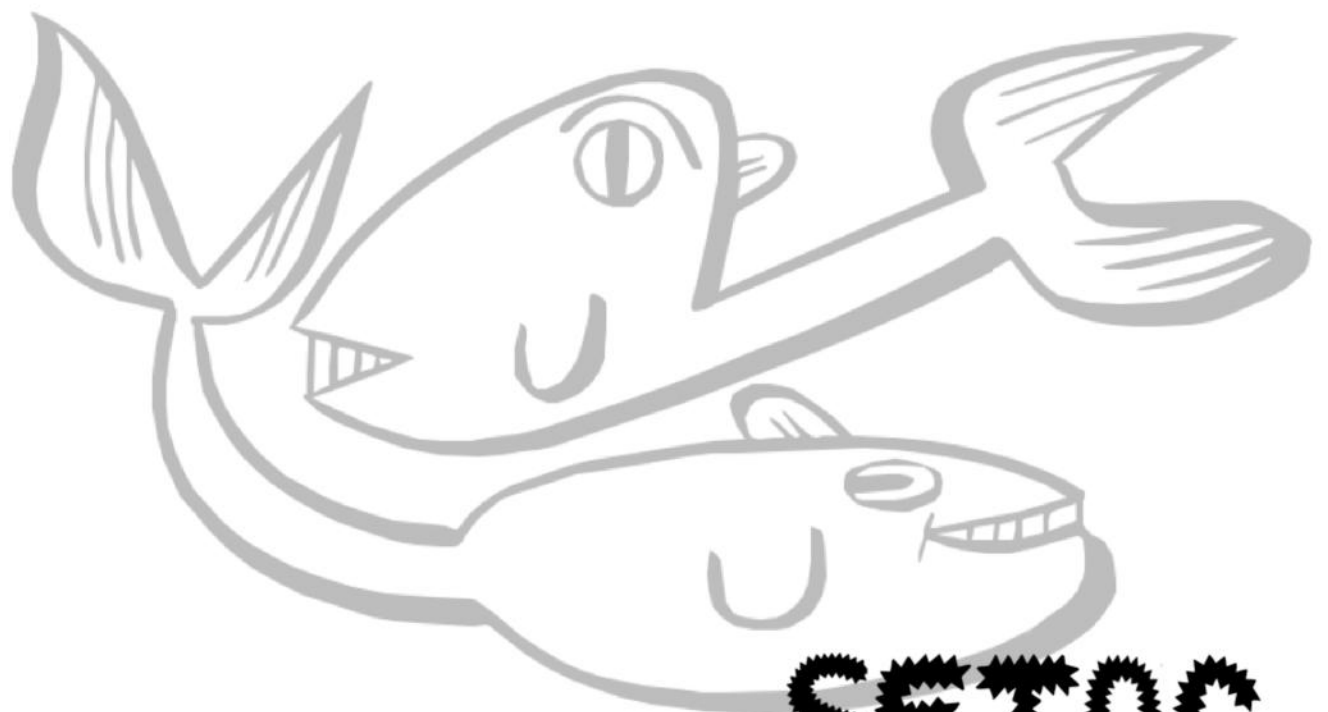

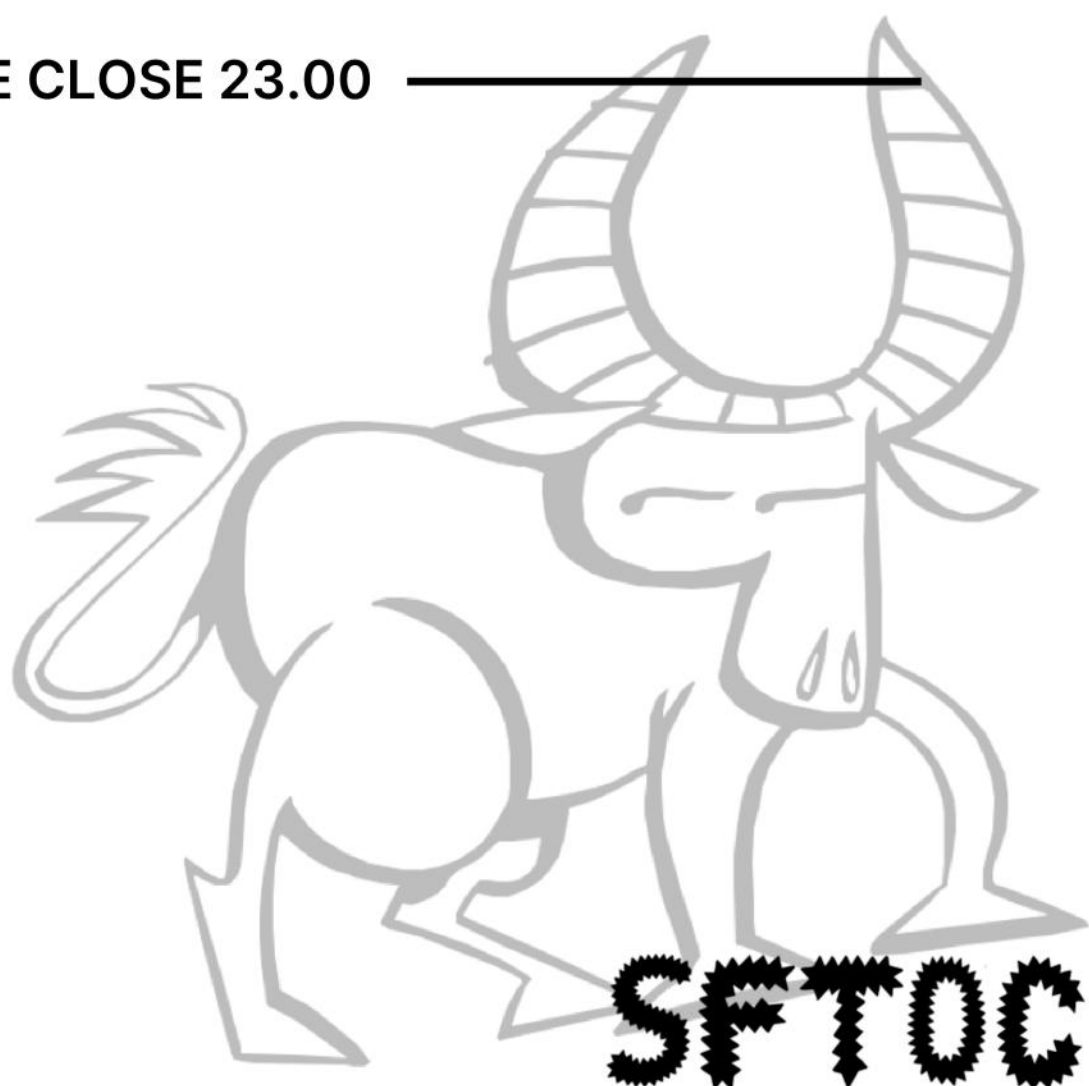
